## The Residences at 19th & Logan Denver, Colorado

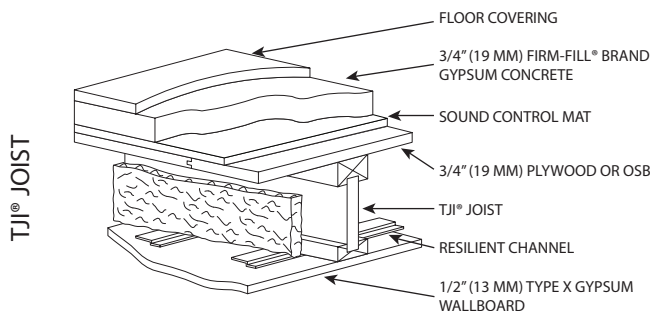
